**PE, Football, Band, Dance, Art, etc. Locker Access will be Friday, May 22, 2020 for all students. Each teacher will be scheduling their own students and will communicate that information directly to the students it affects.**

**PE LOCKER PICK-UP SCHEDULE (FRIDAY, MAY 22)**

To maintain compliance with CDC guidelines during COVID-19, Oviedo High School has designated **Friday, May 22 (one day only)** for ALL PE students to safely collect the contents of your PE locker and remove locks for summer-time deep cleaning. **All items not collected during this time will be disposed of for sanitary reasons.**

## **LOCKER ROOM PICK-UP PROCEDURES AND IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION:**

**For everyone's safety, all students are requested to bring and wear a face mask or covering.**

### **1. Designated Parking Areas:**

**BOYS will park** anywhere on the **front car-rider ramp in front of Admin. Building**, space along the curb (King Street) next to the Stadium and the curb along the Auditorium.

**BOYS: will enter** the courtyard by the glass doors in front of GUIDANCE (Bldg. 1). Look for the flagpole, once you enter look for signs to direct you to line up on the sidewalk along the Admin. Bldg., keeping 6-ft. between you and others. **ONLY BOYS** will enter through the front glass-doors of the PE GYM, in small groups as directed. Then immediately exit the rear door and return to your car on King Street side of campus!

**GIRLS will park** in the back (**Senior**) **parking lot**, then follow the signs toward Bld. 4/PE GYM

**GIRLS: will enter** from (**Senior**) Back parking lot, pass the front of the Media Center (Bldg.5) following the signs posted. Line up on the sidewalk approaching the Rear door, keeping 6-ft. between you and others, waiting patiently to enter the PE GYM. **ONLY GIRLS** will enter here in small groups as directed. Then immediately exit by the fitness room side door of the PE Building and return to your car in Senior parking lot.

ALL doors will be propped open to access the Boys & Girls Lkr. Rooms, so that there will be **NO** need to touch the doors or handles. Follow the markings on the sidewalks to maintain 6-ft. spacing and listen & follow directions of those adults present.

Stand on the marks found on the sidewalk, as you approach your designated entry point to the PE GYM. It is important to follow the 6-ft. spacing at all times!

ALL students will "check-in" with the Coach at the entry door to either the Boys or Girls Lkr. Room. Once there, you will be asked the number of your locker and get your information card.

**Only 3 students will be allowed in the Lkr. Room at a time, 1-student per bay. Your patience is appreciated.**

If you have siblings with PE lockers, **designate one person** to pick up all PE items and locks during one visit. The less people present the safer for all involved.

**STUDENTS – There will be no early entry. Please arrive on time. When waiting outside, please do not congregate in any groups. Remain 6-feet apart and line up in an orderly fashion only 15 students will be admitted into each building at a time)**

**QUESTION: When do I show up to empty my PE Locker?**

**ANSWER: What class period do you have your first or only PE class?**

On the next page, please see the time schedule which is divided into groups based on class periods. That is when you will arrive to line up and wait your turn to be called in.

Regardless of your grade level, please follow the time schedule.
