### Calling all JUNIORS! SAT SCHOOL DAY

The SAT School Day will be held on **Wednesday, March 6, 2019**.

All **juniors** will sit for this nationally recognized assessment which will be administered at no cost to the students. Room assignments will be distributed in late February. In their English classes, juniors will receive a handout telling them "What to Bring/What NOT to Bring on Test Day." They can bring snacks and water for the breaks, and they will go to lunch after the test is finished.

Juniors will be taking the SAT with Essay; total testing/break time is about 4 hours.

### 2019-2020 Registration Process

Students watched the registration video during school on 1/22/19 and received their registration materials (curriculum guide and registration card) through their English class. Anyone who did not receive the materials can pick them up in the front office. The students' current core academic teachers (English, Math, Science and Social Studies) will enter the next academic course they suggest for each student to take. Example: if your student is a 9th grader in Algebra 1 Honors, their current Algebra 1 Honors teacher will enter the next course for them to take that they recommend. They may pick, for example, Geometry Honors. They will meet with the students during class to discuss their selection. If the student and/or parents would like a different class, for example, standard Geometry, the student would need to discuss this with their current teacher. If the teacher is in agreement with this change, they will change their request for the student. If the teacher is not in agreement with the change, they will give the student a Parent Waiver form and the parent can sign it. The students will turn this waiver form in with their course selection card and your student's counselor will change the request in skyward. THIS IS THE ONLY WAY IT WILL BE CHANGED IN SKYWARD. IF THE STUDENT DOES NOT TURN IN A PARENT WAIVER FORM, THEY WILL BE PLACED IN THE CLASS THAT THEIR TEACHER RECOMMENDS FOR THEM.

**Parent Drop-Off and Pick-Up**

Parents, for the safety of our students and staff, please use the following areas to drop off and pick-up your students: Use the ramp in front of the school by the flag pole (preferred), the parking lot in front of the Auditorium, or the parking lot off Pine Street. If you drop your student in a parking lot, please pull all the way into the parking lot before allowing your child to exit your vehicle. Never allow your child to exit on King Street and cross in front of the traffic. Parents are asked to refrain from entering the bus ramp at the east end of the school which is reserved for buses only.

**No Parking in Fire Lanes**

Parents and community members, please be reminded that it is never appropriate to park in the school's fire lanes during after-hours events. An emergency can happen at any time. We have been asked by the county to educate our parents and guests that these fire lanes must remain clear at all times to help streamline emergency response efforts during an emergency event.
