Scholarship Update

Attention all students interested in obtaining scholarships for college: Your College Room is a valuable source of information on scholarships that we hope you will utilize. Beginning in September, seniors and parents of seniors will receive a weekly Skyward blast of the Scholarship Updates. This update will include information about scholarships with approaching deadlines as an encouragement to seniors to apply. Although most scholarships target seniors, many are available to underclassmen as well.

Everyone is encouraged to go to the OHS website > Guidance > Scholarship Info to access this important information. We will also place a copy of the announcement in an orange binder in the college room and ask senior English teachers to post it on their bulletin boards. Applications for the scholarships will be on file in the College Room, and adult dividends are available on some days to assist you in your search. Please take advantage of this service that will be offered throughout the year, and see your counselor if you have questions regarding scholarships.

Attention all students interested in receiving scholarships for college: The months of February and March are important times for applying for scholarships. Many of the scholarships awarded by local clubs and organizations are offered during this time, and several are offered specifically to Oviedo High School students. Make time to visit the college room to take advantage of these scholarship opportunities!

Attention seniors whose parent is a full-time employee of the Seminole County Public School district: Each high school in Seminole County will select one winner of a \$1,000 scholarship to a Florida college or vocational school. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of financial need, academic performance, and an essay. Applications are in the college room and must be turned in to Mrs. Lightsey in the guidance department by the March 4th deadline.

Attention all students: the Veterans of Foreign Wars will award a \$5,000 scholarship to an outstanding scout who is the recipient of a Boy Scout Eagle Award, a Girl Scout Gold Award, A Venture Scout Silver Award, or a Sea Scout Quartermaster Award. Visit the college room to obtain more details about applying for the scholarship. Applications must be submitted to a local VFW post by the March 1st deadline.

Attention seniors: The Central Florida Hotel and Lodging Association is offering a full-ride scholarship to a student planning to pursue a degree at the UCF Rosen College of Hospitality or other Central Florida higher education institution. Applications for the scholarship are in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 15th.

Attention students interested in pursuing a degree in hospitality: The Central Florida Hotel and Lodging Association will award a scholarship of \$1,000 per year for four years to a student with a 3.0 GPA and a financial need. Two additional scholarship opportunities are also available. You can obtain your application in the college room. Deadline to apply is March 22nd.

Seniors, the Hispanic Heritage Scholarship Fund of Metro Orlando is offering scholarships to students of Hispanic heritage who plan to enroll full time in a accredited college or university in Orange, Seminole, Osceola or Lake county. To qualify, you must be of Hispanic heritage and have an unweighted 3.0 GPA. Information about the scholarship is in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 29th.

Attention African-American seniors: The Ivy-N-Pearls foundation will award three \$1,000 scholarships based upon GPA, extracurricular activities, and an essay. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 15th.

Seniors, the Historical Society of Central Florida is sponsoring their annual essay competition for the John Young History Maker Scholarship. One senior in Central Florida will receive a \$2,500 scholarship toward their college education. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to submit your essay and other information requested is March 22nd.

Seniors, if you are the dependent of a deceased or disabled veteran, you may be eligible for a scholarship for Children and Spouses of Deceased or Disabled Veterans and service members. Visit the college room for more information; deadline to apply is April 1st.

Attention Seniors: If you are a dependent of a Walmart Employee, you are eligible to apply for scholarships sponsored by the Walmart Foundation and the Walton Family Foundation. To find out more about these scholarships, please visit the college room. Deadline to apply is April 2nd.

Senior African-American male students are invited to apply for the Jack LeFlore Memorial Scholarship sponsored by the Winter Park Alumni Chapter of the Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity. Up to \$10,000 in scholarships will be awarded. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is April 14th.

Attention all seniors, the Col. George C. Morton Memorial Scholarship is awarded in memory of those personnel who served in a Special Operations Unit. To be eligible, you must be a son, daughter, or grandchild of an individual who served in a Special Operations unit and is an SOA member in good standing. Applications for the scholarship are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is April 15th.

Seniors with a disability who plan to attend a State University System of Florida institution are invited to apply for a scholarship through the Johnson Scholarship Foundation. You may obtain more information about applying for this scholarship in the college room. The deadline to apply is April 15th.

Attention seniors: The Pearlie's Lift Up Scholarship will be awarded to a deserving student who has struggled personally or academically in school, given back through service to his or her community, and wants a second chance in furthering his or her education. Applications are in the college room, and the deadline to apply is April 15th.

Attention seniors, the Foundation for Seminole County Public Schools will award several scholarships to graduating seniors of Seminole County high schools. Among the scholarships that will be awarded to Oviedo High School students are the Colonel Joseph F. Nardo Scholarship and the Catherine "Toots" Nardo Scholarship. There is only one application you must complete to apply for these awards, and that application is available online and can be found at <https://foundationscps.wufoo.com/forms/2019-scps-senior-scholarship-application-application>. The deadline to apply is March 29th and the scholarships will be awarded at Senior Awards Night.

Seniors, the Florida Association of Federal Education Program Administrators will award the Vivian Scott Scholarship to students based upon financial need, academic achievement, and activities. Applications are available in the college room, and completed applications must be turned in to Ms. Lightsey in the guidance office by February 28th.

Seniors, the Rotary Club of Winter Springs Charitable Foundation will award the "Service Above Self" scholarship to a deserving senior. Applications are available in the college room and must be postmarked by the March 16th deadline.

Seniors, the Kiwanis Club of Oviedo/Winter Springs will award a scholarship to a local high school student who has at least a 3.0 grade point average. Applications for the Kiwanis scholarship are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 25th.

Attention seniors, the Rotary Club of Oviedo is offering a four year scholarship of \$1,000 per year to a deserving Oviedo resident. Applications are available in the college room and must be submitted by the March 29th deadline.

Attention seniors: Collins Dental is offering a \$500 scholarship to an Oviedo High School senior who is interested in pursuing a career in the dental or medical field. Applicants must have at least a 3.5 average and must complete an application and essay. Information is available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 20th.

Are you a high school senior who loves Oviedo? If so, you could be this year's recipient of the Oviedo Preservation Project Scholarship. You can find out more information about the scholarship and how to apply in the college room. Deadline is March 30th.

Attention seniors: the Oviedo Historical Society will award a \$1000 scholarship to an Oviedo High School student with a special interest in history. Interested students should complete the application which is available in the college room. Deadline to apply is March 31st.

Attention seniors interested in pursuing a career in engineering and other technical fields. There are several scholarships offered through SAE International for students pursuing degrees in various fields of engineering, science, or technology. Deadline for applying for these scholarships is March 15th, and you can get more information in the college room.

Attention senior girls: the Woman's Club of Sanford will award scholarships based upon GPA, community service, values, career goals, and financial need. Applications for the scholarship is available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 29th.

Attention senior African-American female students: The Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority will award a \$1000 scholarship to one senior in good academic and social standing. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 16th.

Attention seniors of African-American descent: The Kappa Sigma Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority will be awarding scholarships based upon grade point average, achievement in extra-curricular activities, and an essay. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 31st.

Seniors, the Florida Council of the Blind is awarding scholarships to students who are legally blind. Applications for the scholarships are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 24th.

Seniors who have been identified as being legally blind are eligible for scholarships awarded by the Visual Aid Volunteers of Florida, Inc. and the Florida Council of the Blind. Applications for the two scholarships are available in the college room, and the deadlines are March 24th and March 30th.

Seniors, the Janice M. Scott Memorial Scholarship Fund was established to honor her legacy as an advocate for youth and supporter of community service. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA, demonstrate leadership in community service or other extracurricular activities, and have a combined family income of less than \$100,000. Applications for the scholarship are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 31st.

Attention seniors planning to attend Seminole State College: If you have at least a 3.0 GPA, you may be eligible for an Academic or Bright Futures Companion Scholarship to SSC. If you are not sure you will receive the Bright Futures Scholarship, you are advised to apply for the Academic Scholarship since you can apply for only one. If ultimately you do receive the BF, they will award the Companion Scholarship instead. Visit the college room to pick up your application which must be submitted by the March 1st deadline.

Attention seniors, you are encouraged to apply for the Oviedo High School PTSA Scholarship. Scholarships will be awarded on Senior Awards Night to deserving members of the OHS graduating class who are student members of PTSA as of February 1st, have a 2.5 or higher unweighted GPA, and have proof of acceptance to a college or vocational school. You may pick up an application for the scholarship in the college room. Deadline to apply is March 9th.

Attention seniors: The Seminole County Council of PTAs/PTSAs will award scholarships on the basis of financial need and academic performance. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 18th.

Seniors, the Regions Riding Forward Scholarship Essay Contest will award \$5,000 scholarships to 15 high school seniors across the US based upon an essay about an African-American who has inspired and motivated you. Information about the contest is available in the college room, and the deadline to submit your essay is February 28th.

Attention seniors planning to attend Seminole State College: The Wayne M. Densch Scholarship of \$1000 per semester for two years will be awarded to qualified first generation, first time in college students who demonstrate financial need. The priority deadline for applying for this scholarship is March 1st, and you can pick up your application in the college room.

The American Legion Auxiliary will award several scholarships to students who qualify in a variety of categories including children of veterans who served in the Armed Forces or members of the American Legion or Auxiliary. Get more information in the college room to find out how to apply for these scholarships. Deadline to apply is March 1st.

Attention Eagle Scouts: The American Legion is once again sponsoring the Eagle Scout of the Year Scholarship. Winners will receive a \$10,000 scholarship, and runner-up will be granted \$2,500. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 1st.

Attention seniors talented in art and planning to attend SSC: The Winter Springs Festival of the Arts and the Foundation for Seminole State College will award a \$500 scholarship for Visual Arts to one Oviedo High School senior. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 15th.

Attention all students, you are invited to enter an essay contest sponsored by the American Foreign Service Association (AFSA). Awards include a \$2,500 scholarship, an all-expense paid trip to Washington, D.C., and an all-expense paid educational voyage courtesy of Semester at Sea. Information about the essay contest is available in the college room, and the deadline for submission is March 15th.

Attention seniors, the American Association of Blacks in Energy will award scholarships to increase the number of African American, Hispanic, and Native American (underrepresented minorities) in energy related fields. Scholarship awards range from \$1,000 to \$5,000 and are awarded on the basis of academic achievement, extracurricular activities, and financial need. Scholarship applications are in the college room, and the deadline is March 15th.

Seniors, the Chums' Founders' National Scholarship is awarded to benefit students who have a financial need. In addition to having a documented financial need, candidates will be selected on the basis of academic success, ACT/SAT score,

activities, and a personal essay. Applications for the Chums Scholarship are available in the college room and must be submitted by March 16th.

Attention seniors who are members of a single parent family with an annual income of less than \$30,000: The Fred Griffin, Jr. Scholarship Program will award two \$500 scholarships to Central Florida students who meet the financial need and other requirements. More information about the scholarship can be found in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 16th.

Attention all seniors: The Oviedo Woman's Club High School Scholarship will be awarded to one or more Oviedo High School students. You must have a 3.0 or higher cumulative, weighted GPA, and please note that male students are also encouraged to apply for the scholarship. Stop by the college room to pick up your application. Deadline is March 1st.

Seniors, the Oviedo Woman's Club is offering scholarships to Oviedo High School seniors who are planning to attend a Technical School. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 1st.

Attention seniors: If you are a dependent or direct descendant of an active, reserve, retired, or honorably discharged member of the US Navy, Coast Guard, Marines, Merchant Marine, or Sea Cadet Corps, you could be eligible for a scholarship through the Navy League Foundation. Visit the college room for details on how to apply. Deadline is February 15th.

Seniors, the Hispanic Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to students of Hispanic heritage based upon academic achievement and financial need. Application deadline is February 15th, and you can get more information about applying in the college room.

Seniors, the Scholarship for Military Children was created to recognize military families' contributions to the readiness of U.S. armed forces and the commissary's role in the military community. At least one \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to a student at each commissary. Information about applying for the scholarship is available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is February 15th.

Attention all students grades 9-12: The American Legion Auxiliary is sponsoring an essay contest on the topic "How do we keep Lincoln's promise to our veterans and their families?". Winners will receive a \$50 cash prize, and you can visit the

college room for more information. The deadline to submit your essay is February 22nd.

Attention seniors who plan to attend Florida State University: The Service Scholar Program recognizes students with an outstanding record of community service and leadership and want to continue that commitment at FSU. Program benefits include a scholarship valued at \$2,400 per year for up to four years, exposure to a diverse group of individuals and social issues, an academic component, and support by a faculty member. You can obtain more information in the college room. Deadline to apply is February 22nd.

Attention African-American seniors: the Sanford Alumnae Chapter of the Delta Sigma Theta Sorority is offering scholarships to deserving students committed to pursuing a higher education. Factors considered in evaluating applications include leadership, community involvement, academic achievement, and financial need. To access the application, go to Sandfordfldst.com and click on "Programs" at the top of the webpage. Click on "Educational Development", then click icon below Educational Development entitled "DST Scholar.App2019_1.doc". Applications are also available in the college room. Deadline to apply is March 15th

Seniors, the Woman's Club of Winter Park will award scholarships to students based upon their academic record and financial need. Information about applying for the scholarships is available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 1st.

Attention seniors who are children of former, currently serving, or retired commissioned or enlisted military personnel. The Military Officers Association of America Scholarship will provide grants and interest-free loans to qualified students having a 3.0 GPA, extracurricular activities, community service, and a financial need. Visit the college room for information about applying for the scholarship, and the deadline is March 1st.

Seniors, the Marine Corps Scholarship Foundation will award scholarships to children of Marines who plan to attend a non-degree certificate program or vocational training that is 12 months or less at a community college or private career school listed on College Navigator. Get more information about the scholarship in the college room, and the deadline to apply is March 1st.

The Maureen L. and Howard N. Blitman Scholarship to Promote Diversity in Engineering is awarded annually to a high school senior from an ethnic minority

who has been accepted into an accredited engineering program at a four year university. Applications are available in the college room. Deadline to apply is March 1st.

Attention juniors and seniors: Project Yellow Light is a scholarship competition that will awarded scholarships ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 based upon personal expression through billboard design, video, or radio to promote safe driving. Encourage your friends to avoid distracted driving, specifically texting while driving, in a creative way. Information about this scholarship contest is available in the college room, and the first deadline is March 1st.

Attention seniors, Omega Psi Phi and the Bridge Builders Foundation will award \$500-\$1,000 to seniors in Orange and Seminole counties. Winners must have a 3.0 GPA and will be selected on the basis of extracurricular activities and/or community service and a 500 word essay. Deadline to apply is February 1st, and you can get more information about the scholarship in the college room.

Seniors, the Florida Engineering Society will grant six \$2,500 scholarships to seniors who have an interest in pursuing careers in engineering. Information about these scholarships is available in the college room. Deadline to apply is February 9th.

Program benefits include a scholarship valued at \$3000 per year for up to four years, exposure to a diverse group of individuals and social issues, an academic component, and support by a faculty member. You can obtain more information in the college room. Deadline to apply is February 23rd.

Seniors, the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution is offering the Richard and Elizabeth Dean Scholarship of \$5,000 for up to four consecutive years to two high school seniors. Selection will be based on academic merit with an minimum GPA of 4.0. Applications are available in the college room and are due on February 15th.

Seniors, the Jackie Robinson Foundation awards students four-year scholarships of up to \$7,500 per year to attend the four-year college of their choice. To qualify you must be a minority high school senior with leadership potential, be dedicated to community service, and have a financial need. More information is available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is February 1st.

If you are a senior whose parent or grandparent is a member of the Elks Club, you are eligible to apply for a Legacy scholarship of \$4,000. The award will be based upon the core values of knowledge, charity, community, and integrity. Details about applying for the scholarship are available in the college room. Deadline to apply is February 1st.

Attention seniors who are enrolled members of a Native American tribe: The Ann Wood FSSDAR American Indian Endowment Fund Scholarship Fund Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, extracurricular

involvement, and financial need. Applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is February 1st.

Seniors, the Florida PTA offers four scholarship opportunities including one each for university, community college, fine arts, and vocational/technical. Factors considered will be financial need, scholastic achievement, extracurricular activities, and honors awarded. Applications for these \$2,000 scholarships are available in the college room. Deadline to apply is February 1st.

Attention seniors planning to pursue a career in engineering. The Northrop Gruman Scholarship worth \$8,000 over four years will be awarded to two seniors in Seminole and Orange counties. Visit the college room to obtain the website for the application which must be submitted by February 5th.

Attention seniors interested in pursuing a career as a physician. The Seminole County Medical Society Foundation is proud to offer the Dr. Willie Newman Scholarship of \$1,000 which will be awarded to a senior who has met significant life challenges. Get more details about this scholarship in the college room. The deadline to apply is February 8th.

Seniors who wish to further their education in the sciences are encouraged to apply for the Dr. Luis Perez Scholarship which is sponsored by the Seminole county Medical Society Foundation. The scholarship is designed to assist high school seniors who have a 3.5 GPA and who have done well in at least three science courses during high school. Applications are available in the college room. Deadline to apply for this scholarship is February 8th.

Attention students under the age of 18 as of October 1, 2017: You are invited to compete in an essay contest for a \$2,500 scholarship to be awarded by The Optimist International Club. The essay is to be between 700-800 words on an assigned topic, and the deadline for submission is February 9th. Visit the college room to learn more about the essay contest.

Attention seniors, three \$2,500 college scholarships will be awarded to high school seniors who best exemplify their support of the Central Florida Fair, their personal initiative in extracurricular activities, and their own personal attributes that will ensure their success in the arena of higher education. Attention senior girls: Support Our Schools is a nonprofit organization that helps disadvantaged young women attend college by providing a scholarship, a laptop, a mentor, and other support throughout four years of college. Seniors, the Infinite College Scholarship Fair will be held on January 17, 2019 at the Sanford Civic Center from 4:00-7:30. The goal is to assist high achieving students of diversity to obtain the information and funding needed to further their education. Seniors, the Lions Youth Exchange Scholarship is an award of \$1,000 to deserving high school seniors. The scholarships may be used for further education, educational seminars, or educational travel. Deadline to apply is February 15th, and applications are available in the college room.

Seniors, the Oviedo-Winter Springs Lions Club will award a \$1000 book scholarship to an Oviedo High School senior. Applications are available in the college room and must be submitted by February 15th.

Attention seniors interested in becoming an airline pilot: the L3 Airline Academy is offering two seniors scholarships of up to \$35,000 towards your flight training. Scholarship applications are available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is October 26th.

Seniors interested in attending the University of Miami are invited to apply for the George W. Jenkins Scholarship that is worth more than \$50,000 annually. The four-year scholarship is awarded to students based on academic merit, financial need, and an essay that demonstrates a personal history of overcoming adversity. The Ron Brown Scholarship is awarded to African-American seniors who have made significant contributions to their community and is for \$10,000 renewable annually for four years. Students must excel academically, exhibit leadership potential, participate in community service, and demonstrate financial need. Deadline to apply is November 1st, and more information is available in the college room.

Seniors, the Brooks Law Group is offering a scholarship based upon an essay contest. The first place winner will receive a \$1000 scholarship, and the second place winner a \$250 scholarship. Visit the college room to find out the essay topic and get your application. The deadline for submission is November 2nd.

Attention girls in grades 9-12: The National Center for Women & Information Technology (NCWIT) honors young women at the high school level for their computing-related achievements and interests. The scholarships vary in amount from \$1000 to \$50,000. Recipients of academic scholarships are chosen based on Scouting participation, academic performance, and financial need. Merit scholarships are based upon school and

scouting participation, character, and community service. Deadline to apply is October 31st, and you can stop by the college room for more details.

Seniors, the consulting firm of AES Engineers is committed to continuing its support of higher education by providing scholarships to deserving students. The firm will provide a scholarship of \$500 to students interested in a variety of college majors based partly upon an essay you will submit. More information on applying for the scholarship is available in the college room, and the deadline to apply is October 6th.
