- Social Security # Must match name and DOB on record
- Date of Birth Must match SSN and name on record
- First Name Must match SSN and DOB on record
- Middle Initial Must match SSN and DOB on record
- Last Name Must match SSN and DOB on record

- Email address: make sure it's correct in order to receive official communications
- o Identify your school type: Public
- o Identify Florida County where you attended High School: Seminole
- Select Florida HS last attended: Oviedo High School
- o High School Graduation Date: 05/23/2016 (NOT your date of birth)
