Athletics Update from Athletic Director Jen Darty

Girls Varsity Volleyball lost 3-1 to Osceola.

Bowling split with Lake Howell yesterday – the Boys lost but were led by Brendan Carney’s high score of 220 & the Girls won behind Jacquie Gonzalez’s high score of 235.

Girls Volleyball defeated Lake Mary at all three levels. Freshmen won 25-12, 25-6. The Freshmen team was led by Susan Geber & Sascha Levy. JV won 25-20, 25-20 behind the strong play of Kylie O’Brien, Roxy Duda & Mackenzie Holmes. Varsity won in five sets, 24-26, 25-13, 23-25, 25-13, 17-15. Four players had double-doubles for the team – Raven Wrobleski with 26 kills & 15 digs, Caroline Przystup with 20 kills & 27 digs, Paige Wisneski with 30 assists & 11 digs, and Kylie Love with 25 assists & 11 digs. Lily Andrews also added 4 aces & 21 digs. Stephanie Geber & Sydney Gonzales both had 5 blocks.

Girls Golf competed against Lake Brantley and Seminole at Twin Rivers. The team finished with a 248 behind Lake Brantley with 238 & Seminole 234. Top performers for the team were Mya Bremer with a 53 & Rachel Whyte with a 62.

Despite another sub last round by highly ranked Josh Stewart, the Boys Golf team dropped another match by one stroke. Final scores were Lake Brantley 160, Oviedo 161, and Seminole 194.

Bowling went head-to-head vs. Crooms and won on both the Boys & Girls side. The Boys were led by freshmen Andy Rotger with a high score of 213 & the Girls were led by Annie Olay with a high score of 201.

Slow-Pitch Softball came away with two wins yesterday, with a 12-4 win over Seminole and a 10-2 win over Winter Springs. Leading the team was Catherine Buckner who went 6-for-8 with 5 doubles. Also contributing with multiple hits were Makenzie Fore, Erin Kurth, Ava Gelm, Haleigh Slavik, and Alyssa Tossi.

Freshman Football fell to Seminole yesterday 24-0. Marquet Williams led the team in rushing and Cooper Pitman was the leading tackler.

JV Football fell to Seminole 44-0 last night. Jacob Thelen led the team in carries and yards.

Girls Volleyball swept West Orange last night at both levels played. JV won in straight sets behind the strong performance of Jade Boozer, Roxy Duda & Ella Maybin. Varsity won 26-24, 25-17, 25-21. Sydney Gonzales had 4 kills & 3 blocks.

Varsity Football won over University 43-18. Omari Wyatt had 10 carries for 102 yards. Luke Rucker was 16 of 22 for 202 yards and 4 touchdowns. Owen Proth was the leading tackler for the defense.

This school year all events in Seminole County are **cashless**. The Seminole County & FHSAA online ticketing provider is GoFan (www.gofan.co). All tickets will be purchased through GoFan and redeemed electronically on your smart phone at the gate. Upon purchasing tickets, please make sure you do NOT validate them prior to entering the gate. There will not be paper tickets available at the gate. All Fall athletic events, with the exception of Varsity Football, at Oviedo High School are currently available for purchase in GoFan through this link: <https://gofan.co/app/school/FL1808>. For our home Varsity Football games, tickets for general admission will go live online on Monday at 8:00am the week of the home Varsity Football game. Please note, all venues are at limited capacity with a set number of tickets. Once tickets are sold out, we cannot admit any more fans into the stadium. Tickets for our away games in Seminole County will also be available in GoFan when released by the opponent. For our away games in Orange County, they are only permitting two spectators per student-athlete and providing an allotment of tickets to each school that will be distributed by the coach.

For all athletic events, masks are required by SCPS. The administration has the authority by FHSAA to stop the game and require everyone to wear a mask and wear one appropriately meaning covering the nose and mouth area. Please refer to the guidelines for further details.

For our home Varsity Football games, priority parking in the front lot will be \$5 with those spaces for sale in GoFan the week of the game. This parking pass is not your entry to the game as a ticket will also need to be purchased. Free parking is available in the lot off of the bus ramp and the back parking lot. All proceeds from the priority parking lot will go to paying for the turf field.
