Athletics Update from Athletic Director Jen Darty

Varsity Football was cancelled due to rain vs. Deland.

Girls Volleyball hosted the JV Championships and our JV team came away as Tournament Runner-Up. The team swept Lake Highland Prep, The Master's Academy & Dr. Phillips in pool play, continued on with a 2-0 win over Lake Nona in the Semifinals before falling to Hagerty in three sets in the finals. The team had strong play by Katie Saydah, Jess Barker, and Kylie O'Brien.

Swimming & Diving competed in the Lake Brantley Invitational – there were no final scores due to lightning.

Boys Golf competed in the Winter Springs Tournament and finished 8th place overall. Jackson Cammack shot a 78, Hayden Kinder shot an 81, and Andrew Letterman shot an 83.

Bowling split with Lake Brantley yesterday with the Boys winning 2408-1511 and the Girls losing 1213-1209. Andy Rotger had the high game for the Boys at 242 & Spencer Wainright had the high series at 446. For the Girls, Emily Harvey had the high game at 170 & the high series at 323.

Girls Varsity Volleyball won at Timber Creek 32-30, 26-24, 25-22. The team was led offensively by senior Raven Wroblewski with 18 kills & senior Caroline Przystup with 12. Senior Kylie Love had 23 assists & sophomore Paige Wisneski had 22. Senior Sara Ferrer had 19 digs and junior Lily Cammack added 14. The JV team also won over Timber Creek in straight sets led by Addie Imbs, Mackenzie Holmes & Carley Michnoff. The Freshmen team fell in two sets, losing their first match of the season.

Swimming won over Hagerty & Lake Brantley yesterday. The Girls won over Lake Brantley 176-129 & Hagerty 245-54 with wins coming from diver Molly Connell with a 219, Marin Rose in the 200 Free at 1:55 and the 500 Free at 5:07, Kaylin Herbet took the Sprints with a 24 in the 50 & a 52 in the 100, and Izzy Bishop won the 100 Back with a 59. On the Boys side, we defeated Lake Brantley 186-104 & Hagerty 231-45. Wins came from diver Carson Powers with a 242, Luca Oliva in the 100 IM with a 154, Andrew Christensen in the 200 and the 500 with a 145 and a 4:48, and Ryan Walker took the 100 Free with a 50.0.

Bowling fell to Hagerty on both sides yesterday – Boys lost 2649-2525 & Girls lost 1519-1236. Andy Rotger had a 247 high game for the Boys & Adrian Maduro had a 480 high series. For the Girls, Emily Harvey led the way with a 143 high game & 284 high series.

Girls Freshmen & JV Volleyball took on Winter Park and Timber Creek in a tri-match yesterday. The Freshmen team swept both opponents led by Meghan Maddox, Josie Harshbarger, Janelle Baez, and Haley Kissane. The JV team split by beating Timber Creek 2-0 & falling to Winter Park 1-2. The JV team had strong play from Jade Boozer, Izzy Prescott, Alexis Felker, and Emme Noteboom.

Freshmen Football won over Lake Howell 39-0 before getting called due to weather. Jerome Curry had 2 passing TDs, Dalton Hitt had 1 passing TD, Brady Manning had 2 receiving TDs, Jaylen Lewis had 1 receiving TD, Joey Goia had 2 rushing TDs, and Aiden Mahaffey had 1 interception.

Boy's golf beat Seminole yesterday 176-195. The Lions were led by Noah Andrescik with a 37, Jackson Cammack with 38, and Hayden Kinder with 39.

SCPS collaborates with the Seminole Department of Health to conduct contact tracing and determine isolation or quarantine length after positive test or exposure to a COVID positive individual. On September 22nd, the Florida Department of Health issued Emergency Rule 64DER21-15, which outlined quarantine updates for students in the school setting. SCPS has adjusted their guidelines in accordance to these rules to be effective immediately. The most updated student isolation and quarantine protocols are outlined below.

<p>Student Tests Positive for COVID-19 or Displays Symptoms Consistent with COVID-19</p>	<p>Return From Isolation Protocols:</p>
<p>Student must isolate from school until they satisfy one of the Isolation Return Protocols.</p>	<p>Student can return on Day 11 after symptom onset or on Day 11 after positive test date if no fever for 24 hours and symptoms are improving; <u>OR</u></p> <p>Student can take a COVID-19 diagnostic test (antigen or PCR) and return to school IF they are asymptomatic AND provide negative test results to the school; <u>OR</u></p> <p>The student receives written permission to return to school from a medical doctor licensed under chapter 458, Florida Statutes or osteopathic physician licensed under chapter 459, Florida Statutes or a advanced registered nurse practitioner licensed under chapter 464, Florida Statutes</p>
<p>Student is exposed to COVID-19 individual at school or in the community</p>	<p>Quarantine Protocols for Asymptomatic Students:</p>
<p>Parents or legal guardians of students who are known to have been in direct contact with an individual who received a positive diagnostic test for COVID-19 may choose either quarantine option.</p> <p>Direct contact is defined as any person within 6 feet of a COVID-19 positive individual cumulatively for 15 minutes or more.</p>	<p>Parents/guardians can choose to quarantine student for a period of time not to exceed 7 days from last date of contact with the COVID positive individual. <u>OR</u></p> <p>Parents/guardians can allow the student to attend school, school sponsored activities, or be on school property so long as the student remains asymptomatic.</p>

If an exposed student develops symptoms during quarantine, they must meet the return to school protocols for symptomatic/COVID positive students.

In addition, anyone currently in quarantine must be allowed to return, if asymptomatic, upon parent request. No testing is required to return back from quarantine.
