Course Selection for 2024-2025 School Year

In January and February of each school year, students are provided with opportunities and resources to learn about course offerings at Oviedo High School. Those include:

- Curriculum Night January 18, 2024 learn about Advanced Placement, Career & Technical classes, and well as electives
- OHS Curriculum Guide
- Video overview of the OHS Course Selection process

For Current OHS Students:

From January 19 through February 6, students can enter their elective course requests into Skyward *Course Requests*. Core courses are recommended by student's current teachers, loaded in Skyward by February 12, and can be changed by School Counselors with parent permission. Directions for entering elective course requests into Skyward:

Quick Reference Guide for current OHS 9th, 10th, and 11th graders - Student Access: Course Requests

- 1. Access Skyward through the Clever Portal or by going directly to https://skyward.scps.k12.fl.us and choosing Family/Student Access. Log in using your student ID and network password. This feature is available only from the student's Skyward account, not the parent account.
- 2. Click on **Schedule** on the left then click on **Request Courses for 2024-2025 in Oviedo High School** at the top.
- 3. Select a course from the *Available Courses* and click **Add Course**. Be sure to only select electives that you have the proper pre-requisites for otherwise you will be dropped from the course at the beginning of the school year. Check the OHS Curriculum Guide for pre-requisites.
- 4. Repeat this process until all three (3.0) elective credits have been selected.
- 5. Now click on the tab **Request Alternates** to select your Alternate Course Requests.
- 6. The same process described above will be used to select courses from the Alternate Course(s) Available list, make sure to choose at least 3 alternates.
 - a. Alternates will appear ranked in preference by the order in which they were selected.
 - b. Order can be adjusted by using the Move Up or Move Down buttons
 - c. Alternates can be changed using the **Remove Course** button
- 7. Once the request is completed, Logout of Student Access.

Note: Students may have trouble adding elective courses that require auditions or selection. Students can use the Course Change Request Form to "Add" those course requests to Skyward.

<u>Current 8th grade students who attend a private or charter school and live in the Oviedo High School attendance zone</u>: Start the process on or after February 1 by completing the <u>SCPS enrollment process</u>.

If you are do not live in the Oviedo High School attendance zone and have not been assigned to attend Oviedo High School by the SCPS SAPA (Student Assignment and Program Access) department, please visit their website. Information for the '24-'25 school year transfers will be available on the website on February 1st. The SAPA transfer application period is February 1, 2024 - March 1, 2024, for all transfers EXCEPT for the Controlled Open Enrollment Transfers which is from April 15, 2024 - May 15, 2024. You will be notified via email directly from the SAPA department after each transfer period closes on the status of your application.

Students who have not yet enrolled may select and submit course requests, but no schedule will be built for students who are not enrolled or assigned to Oviedo High School. They may use the same links provided at the top of this page.
